

History:

The idea of holding an international exhibition of police, safety, and security equipment, with the abbreviation IPAS, was formed in 2002 with the initiative of the country's commander in chief of the police. In March of the same year, the first fair under the title of IPAS 2002 was held in the field of police and security equipment at the conference center of IRIB in Tehran in which the products of 115 companies from 19 countries were presented. After that, the IPAS exhibition was registered in the trade and development organization's exhibition calendar in Iran and an exclusive permit was granted to it. In that period, the organizer attempted to take effective measures to achieve the current standards and to solve previous problems and defects. Now the international exhibition of police, security, and safety equipment and supplies has managed to achieve a worthy position among the exhibitions of the country and is welcomed by hundreds of domestic and foreign companies and tens of thousands of visitors every year.


